Remember, your child's participation is completely confidential and IP addresses will not be tracked. There are no known risks to your child if he/she decides to participate in this survey. Their responses will not be identified with them personally. All answers your child provides will be combined with all other student answers and presented as an average response in any reports given to students, school staff, or parent groups.

This survey will take approximately 20 minutes for your child to complete. Participation is voluntary. Your child may stop at any time and there is no penalty if he/she decides not to complete it. Although the survey is voluntary, I hope that you will encourage your child to complete it because the information will be extremely useful to our school in determining what issues are of importance to our community. There are open-ended questions at the end of the survey to give voice to students regarding what issues they believe are most relevant to them.

This survey asks questions about sensitive topics. If some of the questions bring up emotions or thoughts that cause your child distress, school counselors will be available to help.
